- 1. Mayor Williams called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and called roll with the following members present: Mayor Rhonda Williams, Christina Porath, Keith Chitwood and Colby Collinsworth.
- 2. <u>Swear In Proceedings for May Perales and Tammy Crosswhite to serve as Council Members</u> City Secretary Edie Sims performed the swearing in ceremony for May Perales and Tammy Crosswhite. Both new members took their seats as City Council Members.
- 3. <u>First Public Hearing to receive public comments, and discuss a request to replat a Preliminary</u> Plat known as Deer Creek Ranch Estates, an addition located at the northwest corner of <u>County Road 619 and County Road 574, also known as Abstract A0556 Joseph Mathews</u> <u>Survey, Sheet 2, Tract 47, containing 49.093 acres and Abstract A0556 Joseph Mathews</u> <u>Survey, Sheet 1, Tract 84 containing 9.10 acres, replatting into 58.19 acres and containing 43</u> <u>total lots and also located within the Extra Territorial Jurisdiction of the City of Blue Ridge</u>

Mayor Rhonda Williams opened the Public Hearing at 7:03pm and asked those FOR the Final Plat to come forward. Tom Jones, engineer for the project, was present and prepared to answer any questions. With no one coming forward, Mayor Williams asked those OPPOSING to come forward. With no one coming forward, Mayor Williams closed the Public Hearing at 7:07pm.

4. First Public Hearing to receive public comments, and discuss a request for a Preliminary Plat known as Qariyah Addition, an addition located on FM 2756 and County Road 495; also known as Abstract 936 D Van Winkle Survey, Sheet 3, Tract, 215 containing 33.24 acres and Abstract 936 D Van Winkle Survey, Sheet 3, Tract 109 containing 17.45 acres for a total of 50.69 acres with 39.92 acres being developed; and also which is located within the City of Blue Ridge's Extra Territorial Jurisdiction

Mayor Rhonda Williams opened the Public Hearing at 7:08pm and asked those FOR the Preliminary Plat to come forward. Niem Khan, engineer for the project, was present and prepared to answer any questions. With no one else coming forward, Mayor Williams as those OPPOSING the Preliminary Plat to come forward. Christina Porath questioned if the water has been resolved to provide for this project. Habiba Sultana, one of the owners and developers, stated they have a letter from Verona Special Utility District stating water can be provided. Nathan McTee, President of the Board for Verona Special Utility District and wife Liz McTee stated the letter was from a year ago and many developments have changed, thereby the need for the review to be done again to ensure water service. Mrs. Sultana also stated the original plans were for 41 homes but will now be 36 homes.

Cathy Smith, residing at 2380 CR 495, and adjacent to this development stepped forward with a lengthy list of questions: water availability and usage; blocked water flow; Fannin County Electric electricity availability; road detriment during construction and effect on existing roads; new entrances and exit; loss of residential utilization; no sidewalks, CR 495 is on a culde-sac; traffic congestion; new traffic and deliveries; wireless resources – already inadequate;

cell phones already have spotty coverage; trash and recycling; noise pollution; harmful emissions; air pollution; ground contamination; runoff to existing ponds; wildlife concerns; requested larger land lots; questioned if studies done regarding impact to wildlife; if environmental study was done; and asked for added trees to help the environment.

Mrs. Prater, residing at 2395 CR 495, stated she did not receive any notification and had the same concerns as Mrs. Smith.

With no one else coming forward, Mayor Williams closed the Public Hearing at 7:29pm.

5. First Public Hearing to receive public comments, and discuss a request for a Concept Plan and Annexation request for a subdivision known as Parkside Addition or Blue Ridge Crossing (name has not been finalized), an addition situated as being part of the Mathias Mowery Survey, Abstract 557, being part of 317.764 acre tract of land conveyed to Michael McCreary and Chad Knowles for a total of 42.572 acres of land, also known as the property south of the Blue Ridge Area Sports Association land and also is intended to be annexed within the incorporated limits of the City of Blue Ridge

Mayor Rhonda Williams opened the Public Hearing at 7:30pm and asked those FOR the Concept Plan to come forward. Mitchell Fielding, developer from F2 Capital Partners, LLC, came forward stating the Concept Plan will be up to 220 homes. The lot sizes are planned for 50'x115' = 5750 square feet. Jeff Carey, President of Blue Ridge Area Sports Association, came forward stating this is the first to meet the developers but BRASA is definitely interested in a partnership to share the BRASA Sports Park. Mr. Fielding stated he has full intentions of working with BRASA. There are other considerations such as road improvements, more particularly Pruett Street. The property is located within the City's Extra Territorial Jurisdiction and is contiguous to the City. Mr. Fielding also stated he has full intentions of annexation.

Mayor Williams asked those OPPOSING the Concept Plan to come forward. Jorge Jimenez, residing at 300 Scott Road, expressed concerns of runoff, drainage and ensuring the flood plain is dealt with. Mr. Fielding stated once he is further in the development agreement with the City, a flood study will be performed.

Christina Porath questioned the price range for the homes, with Mr. Fielding stating \$250 – 350,000. The timeframe for Phase 1 is 12 - 18 months. Also, Mr. Fielding stated he has acquired Mark Littlejohn's property on South Business Highway 78 to assist with the entry of the development. There will be traffic studies as well to determine a 3rd access point.

Commeal Shinn, residing at 320 S Morrow, stated she opposes the project. Morrow Street cannot handle more traffic as the street is not in great condition now. She stated she enjoys looking at the country side and not look forward to seeing homes in it's place. The streets were improved in 1991 and have not been improved since. She stated she would rather keep the small country feel than for the City to have improved streets and more income with these new homes.

Nathan McTee, residing at 5765 CR 570, stated he was one of the founders of BRASA and requested to keep this park for the kids.

Randal Shinn asked the square footage of the homes with Mr. Fielding replying the range will be from 1600 – 2100 square foot. A Homeowner's Association will also be established. Presently, builders have not been identified, but he is speaking with Stonehollow Homes. There will be sidewalks in the subdivision. Rental restrictions will also need to be discussed.

With no one else coming forward, Mayor Williams closed the Public Hearing at 7:49pm.

- <u>Prayer and Pledges of Allegiance</u> City Secretary Edie Sims performed the prayer and pledges to the American and Texas Flags.
- 3. <u>Announcements relating to items of public interest</u>: Due to being under full construction on Business Highway 78 and FM 545, the Christmas Parade has been cancelled. On a positive note, our Public Works Director Brad Meserole spoke with TxDOT contractor and the City will be receiving all the asphalt millings from the TxDOT jobs. A water and sewer improvement project has been started on South Main Street. The original water line is 1" feeding 10+ homes. The water line will be increased to 4" and a manhole will be installed increasing sewer capacity in this area. South Main will be improved from rock to the reclaimed asphalt after the utility project has been completed. The street will be similar to High Ridge upon completion. An error was made by Edie Sims whereas the Worth Addition Plat was not on this agenda. Apologies to the Worth family and the plat will be presented at the earliest opportunity.





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

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### CITY OF BLUE RIDGE ORDINANCE 2021-1207-001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE, TEXAS, REQUIRING SPECIFIED WATER METERS WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE OR WHERE THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE PROVIDES WATER SERVICE; PROVIDING VERIFICATION; PROVIDING OF WATER METER REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Ridge, Texas ("City") is a Type A General Law Municipality located in Collin County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Texas Local Government Code, and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has installed a specific Automated Meter Reading infrastructure to better benefit and improve the water utility for the citizens residing inside the incorporated limits of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is requiring any meters installed within the City of Blue Ridge and any service outside the City of Blue Ridge for the purpose of providing water to residential, commercial, and/or industrial customers within the City of Blue Ridge shall be a type and brand specified by the City of Blue Ridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the City shall specify this type and brand of water meter to be consistent with those meters utilized by the City of Blue Ridge for the purpose of providing water to residential, commercial, and/or industrial customers within the City of Blue Ridge; and

**WHEREAS**, all meters shall have functioning remote read capabilities and shall be Zenner Multi-Jet Type Magnetic Drive Cold Water Meters NITRO I, Model PMN;

WHEREAS, all meters shall have a Stealth Reader Meter Interface Unit allowing for 2-way communication, and information migration; and

**WHEREAS**, all connections of the meters shall have Techflex sleeving to protect the wiring from rodents and other factors which disrupt the connection and information migration; and

WHEREAS, all meters shall use Hydroconn Connectors AMR Series III cables to improve the cable/connectors reliability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE, TEXAS:

### SECTION 1: INCORPORATION OF FINDINGS

The findings set forth above are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes as if fully set forth herein.

### SECTION 2: VERIFICATION

a) All persons, firms, and/or corporations which install water meter(s) within the City of Blue Ridge or where the City of Blue Ridge provides water service outside the City of Blue Ridge to serve residential, commercial, and/or industrial customers shall, prior to installation, obtain authorization from the City of Blue Ridge to install such water meters.

- b) Approval of such installation of the City of Blue Ridge shall be based upon verification by an authorized representative of the person, firm, and/or corporation that the water meters conform to the City of Blue Ridge's specified type of water meter. The process for approval shall be in a manner determined by the City of Blue Ridge.
- c) Upon completion of the installation of such water meters, and authorized agent of the person, firm, and/or corporation installing the water meter(s) shall certify the water meters conform to the City of Blue Ridge's specifications for water meters. Upon installation and prior to use of the water meter, the meter interface unit (MIU) identification number and the meter number shall be furnished to the City of Blue Ridge. The process for approval shall be in a meter determined by the City of Blue Ridge.

### SECTION 3: WATER METER REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS

- a) Any water meter installed by a person, firm, and/or corporation that ceases to properly function, either in terms of miscalculation or failure to properly broadcast readings, shall be repaired and/or replaced within five business days of notification by the City of Blue Ridge to the person, firm, and/or corporation.
- b) The City of Blue Ridge shall be notified in writing of any water meter repairs and/or replacements within five business days of the repair and/or replacement.
- c) In completing a replacement of a water meter

### SECTION 4: PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE

- a) Criminal penalties.
  - Any violation or failure to abide by, and comply with, any provision or requirement of this article shall be a violation, and shall be punishable as a class "C" misdemeanor, subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 per occurrence.
  - 2. Each day upon which there exists a violation of this article, or a failure to abide by, or comply with, any provision or requirement of this article, shall constitute a separate occurrence, and shall subject the offer to separate criminal penalties.
  - 3. Prosecution pursuant to this article is in addition to and does not supplant other remedies.
- b) Civil penalties.
  - 1. Civil penalties may be imposed for the violation of any provision of this article, as follows:

a. Up to \$1,000.00 for each violation, and each day of a continuing violation may be considered a new violation; and/or

b. If applicable, default and revocation of any or all authorization granted to allow the installation of water meters in the City of Nederland, subject to the procedural guidelines noted in this ordinance, and further subject to any limitations imposed by federal or state law.

- 2. In imposing the penalties and the amount, the city may weigh all applicable factors, such as damages caused by the violation, reasons for the violation, the seriousness of the violation, and the other factors.
- 3. Monetary civil penalties may be imposed in the manner prescribed by either local or state law.

4. In addition, the city council may order specific performance of any actions required by this article.

### SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council the several provisions of this Ordinance are severable. In the event any court of competent jurisdiction shall judge any provisions of this Ordinance to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, such judgment shall not affect any other provisions of this Ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

### SECTION 6: REPEALER

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other Ordinances, resolutions, and/or policies of the City, whether written or otherwise, and shall not repeal any of the provisions of those ordinances except in those instances where the provisions of those ordinances direct conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance. Any and all Ordinances, resolutions, and/or policies of the City, whether written or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

### SECTION 7: PUBLICATION

The City Secretary is hereby directed to publish in the Official Newspaper of the City of Blue Ridge the caption, penalty and effective date clause of this Ordinance as required by Section 52.011 of the Local Government Code.

### SECTION 8: SAVINGS

All rights and remedies of the City of Blue Ridge are expressly saved at to any and all violations of the provisions of any Ordinances which have accrued at the time of the effective date of this Ordinance; and, as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such Ordinances, same shall not be affected by this Ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the courts.

### SECTION 9: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption in accordance with and as provided by Texas law.







**APPLICATION:** The Encoded Type Register (ETRU) is designed for use with ZENNER PMN (MTK), PPD (RTK), ZTM, ZTMB and FHZ meter series registers to provide either an encoded or pulse output.

**MOUNTING:** The ETRU mounts onto the mounts onto the meter shroud using two flat head tamper screws that are provided. A special tool is required to install or remove the ETRU. The ETRU can be removed from the meter without disrupting water service.



MAGNETIC PICKUP: Magnetic pickup from the register pointer ensures reliable positive readings.

SEALED ETRU: The ETRU is completely sealed and approved for pit conditions.

**CONSTRUCTION:** The housing of the ETRU is constructed of an environmentally safe plastic and resin. Internal construction materials are designed for long-life and reliability. The potting compound provides an impenetrable barrier against water and natural contaminants.

**TEMPERATURE:** The operating range of the ETRU is -20° C to 76° C (-4° F to 169°F). The water meter should not be exposed to temperatures below freezing.

**WIRE CONNECTIONS:** The ETRU is provided as a factory pre-wired assembly or an individual unit that can be wired in the field. Length of the connecting wires is limited by the limitations of the connected AMR device.

**TAMPER-PROOF FEATURES:** Customer removal of the ETRU can be detected by a built in electronic feature of the unit.

**ELECTRONCS:** The circuit board is completely sealed against moisture and humidity.

**OPERATING CHARACTERISTICS:** The ETRU has an output every revolution of the pointer. The ETRU generates one count for every rotation of the sweep hand. It will not decrement the count with reverse rotation, and will internally count up to 50 consecutive reverse rotations. This feature is provided to ensure that if a forward rotation is followed by a reverse rotation, the reverse flow will not cause the forward flow to be counted twice. A maximum of 50 consecutive reverse rotations is allowed for.




