**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Sealed bids will be received in the office of the City Secretary of the City of Blue Ridge, City Hall, 200 S. Main, Blue Ridge Texas 75424, until **3:00 p.m., Thursday, January 3, 2019**, then publicly opened and read at the Civic Center located at 200 W. Tilton Street, Blue Ridge, Texas 75424, for furnishing all necessary materials, machinery, equipment, superintendence, and labor for **Ridgeway Drive Roadway and Waterline Rehabilitation** for the City of Blue Ridge. This project includes construction of approximately 5,630 square yards of asphalt rehabilitation (TxDOT Item 251) and 1,830 linear feet of 8-inch water line, along with all appurtenances.

Bidders must submit Cashier's or Certified Check, issued by a bank satisfactory to the City of Blue Ridge, or Bid Bond issued by a bonding company satisfactory to the City of Blue Ridge, payable without recourse to the order of the City of Blue Ridge in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the largest possible bid submitted as a guaranty that Bidder will enter into contract and execute Bond and Guaranty in the forms provided within ten (10) days after Notice of Award of Contract to him. Bids without required check or bid bond will not be considered.

The successful bidder must furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract price from a Surety Company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as Surety. Should the total contract price be less than \$25,000.00, no performance bond or payment bond will be required.

All lump sum and unit prices must be stated in both script and figures on the forms provided. The City of Blue Ridge reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive formalities. In case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating prices in the bids, the City of Blue Ridge reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof, or to reject the bid. Unreasonable (or "unbalanced") unit prices will authorize the City of Blue Ridge to reject any bid.

Bidders are expected to inspect the site of work and to inform themselves regarding all local conditions.

Attention is called to the fact that there must be paid on the project not less than the general prevailing rates of wages which have been established by the City of Blue Ridge.

Plans and specifications will be electronically posted on Civcast. Plans purchased from Plan Rooms or third-party websites shall be at the Bidder's sole risk. No guarantee of receipt of Addenda, as clarifications will be made for third-party downloads. Plans and specifications may also be examined, without charge, or purchased at the office of the City Engineer; Birkhoff, Hendricks & Carter, L.L.P. located at 11910 Greenville Ave., Suite 600, Dallas, Texas 75243. The cost for the plans and specifications are \$25.00 per set (non-refundable) and will be available beginning December 20, 2018.
